We strongly encourage our fanau, parents and caregivers to work in partnership with our kura to support the learning of our rangatahi. The learning, achievement and success of your fanau is important to us, we have high expectations for them and believe they can achieve personal excellence.

Learning queries are welcome at anytime, you can phone or email to make an appointment or query about your tamaiti / moko. See over the page for important email contacts.

Your learning query may be related to:

- Your tamaiti/ moko's Engagement Report.
- Your tamaiti/ moko's relationship with their faiako.
- The amount of homework your tamaiti/ moko is receiving.
- You may be wanting to understand an assessment better so you can help your tamaiti/ moko.
- You may be wanting regular reports from the faiako and kura to support your tamaiti/ moko.
- You may just want to know your tamaiti/ moko's faiako better.

When you would like to make a query about the learning of your fanau, the best place to start is with the subject teacher/ faiako. Issues or problems with learning relationships, your tamaiki or moko's learning or assessments and homework are best addressed closest to the classroom.

Our AIGA Faiako Vetekina Pekipaki can be present at any meetings to support the fanau. If you would like our AIGA Faiako present, please request this when you speak to the teacher or Dean.

If your learning query is not addressed satisfactorily by the faiako/ teacher then either contact your tamaiti/ moko's Year Level Dean for pastoral queries or the Head of Faculty for academic queries and work with them to resolve any issues that exist.

When issues are not able to be addressed and resolved by the Year Level Dean, it will be passed on to the Deputy Principal or Senior Leader who is responsible for that year level. If for any reason you child prefers to speak to a male or female member of staff then please clearly articulate this to our Deans and they will make an alternative arrangement.
